



## Sarajevo – Travnik – Mostar – Blagaj – Počitelj – Konjic - Sarajevo Program 5 Days/ 4 Nights ( Half board )

### Day 1 SARAJEVO – ARRIVAL ( Dinner )

Arrival at Sarajevo Airport. Departure with all possible assistance for a short Panoramic tour of Sarajevo. Proceed to the hotel. Check-in the hotel. Dinner and Overnight

### Day 2 SARAJEVO – Locco – ( Breakfast – Dinner )

Breakfast at hotel. 08,00h drive to Vrelo Bosne – spring of river Bosna, Tunnel museum – the only means of going in and out during the siege of Sarajevo in last war. 10.00h proceed to the Old Town, Walking tour of old town Bascarsija, Latin bridge, place where the Austro Hungarian Archduke was assassinated, what triggered the 1st World War; Brusa bezistan - covered market place; Gazi Husrev Bey Mosque- built in 1530 year during the Ottoman era - and Gazi Husrev Bey Madrasah; Morica han built in 1551; Vijecnica - town hall for the Austro-Hungarian era. Proceed to mountain Bjelašnica for a pleasant walk on the fresh air. The Bjelašnica Mountain (2,067 m) is a large mountain with spacious slopes, which are under snow cover for more than six months a year. The mountain was the site of several of the most attractive alpine ski competitions during the 14th Winter Olympic Games in 1984. The Igman Mountain (1,502 m) is located several minutes away from the Bjelašnica Mountain. The mountain is prized with beautiful hiking trails and exceptionally clean air. During the Winter Olympic Games, the Igman Mountain hosted Nordic events and ski jumping competitions. The Bjelašnica and Igman Mountains are among the leading tourist attractions of Sarajevo.. Back to Sarajevo. Free at leisure. Dinner and Overnight

### Day 3 SARAJEVO – TRAVNIK - SARAJEVO ( Breakfast – Dinner )

Breakfast at hotel. 08,00h drive to city Travnik ( 95 KM ) For over 150 years, the vizier - the Ottoman Sultan's representative in Bosnia - had his headquarters in this town, attracting both consulates and trade. Travelers visiting Travnik in this era were impressed by the town and called it the European Istanbul and the most oriental town in Bosnia. Upon arrival, visit of the Old Town, Museum (birth house of the famous nobel prize winner Ivo Andrić) and Sulejmanija Mosque (Colorful Mosque), Back to Sarajevo. Free at leisure. Dinner and Overnight.

### Day 4 SARAJEVO – MOSTAR ( Breakfast – Dinner )

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out the hotel. 08,00h drive to city Mostar. Arrive at 10,00, start with city tour - visit Karadžić bey mosque, Muslibegović house - walk through the old town and old bridge, listed as UNESCO heritage site. Free time for personal activities. Proceed to hotel. Check-in the hotel. Free time. Dinner and Overnight

### Day 5 MOSTAR – SARAJEVO ( Breakfast )

Breakfast at hotel. Check-out the hotel. Departure to Sarajevo Airport, final departure.
